With a success rate of just 22%, brain cancer is on the increase across Western Sydney. Music for Life is committed to not only raising much needed funds for Brain Cancer Research but is also dedicated to raising and maintaining awareness of this crippling disease. Unlike some fields of cancer research, brain cancer research only receives a fraction of funding compared to other foundations.

Brain cancer, which kills more children than any other cancer, is also the leading cause of cancer death in adults aged under 40 in Australia. Yet very little is known about brain cancer, its causes or how to treat it. Approximately 1600 brain cancers are diagnosed annually in Australia; that is roughly one person diagnosed with brain cancer every five hours.

To date, Music for Life has raised over \$154,000 that has gone directly to Dr Charles Teo's Cure Brain Cancer Foundation. The foundation is driving the national research agenda for brain cancer. As the largest dedicated fundraiser for brain cancer research in Australia, they are mobilising communities. Their mission is bold: to increase five-year survival to 50% within 10 years through a co-ordinated effort between research, patients, government and the support of community events like Music for Life.
